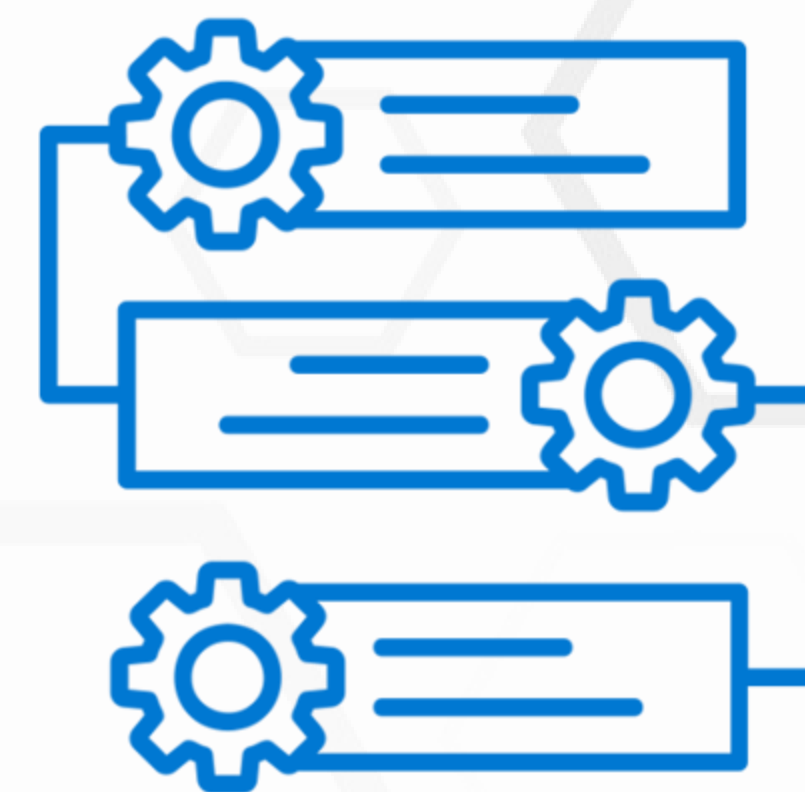

TENTATIVE WORK PROGRAM CYCLE

Abbreviated Cycle

1

JUNE – AUGUST:

Interact with elected officials. Balances Tentative Work Program to allocations received.

2

OCTOBER:

Conduct Districtwide Public Hearing and present to sub-committees.

3

OCTOBER:

Present to Monroe County Board of County Commissioners and Miami-Dade County Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) Governing Board.

4

NOVEMBER/DECEMBER:

Compile District plans to create the Statewide Tentative Work Program. Submit Statewide preliminary draft Tentative Work Program to Governor's Office, Legislature, Florida Transportation Commission and Department of Economic Opportunity.

5

JANUARY:

Florida Transportation Commission (FTC) conducts a statewide public hearing to receive public input for the Tentative Work Program. The Florida Legislature also convenes in January.

6

JULY:

After the appropriations are approved by the Legislature, the Work Program is adopted by the FDOT State Secretary.

- Reconstructing an area of the intersection
- Installing a pump station to minimize flooding

STABILIZATION PROJECT – 454029-1

Status

- Design is underway

Project Details

- Stabilize the shoreline along SR 5/US 1 in the Florida Keys to reduce erosion
- Protect critical transportation infrastructure
- Improve resilience against coastal storms.



KEY WEST INT'L AIRPORT TERMINAL CONCOURSE A

IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – 447911-1

Status

- Construction underway – Phase 2
- Expected completion summer 2026

Project Details

- 50,000 square-foot facility with eight gates
- New pedestrian bridge and new rental car counters
- Designed to withstand 200 miles per hour winds and storm surge

Project Details

- Review and analyze potential impacts for the proposed transportation improvement
- Preserving the operational integrity and regional functionality of I-95, and the regional transportation network throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach Counties
- Enhancing emergency evacuation and response times
- Offer more mobility options for motorists and transit users
- Provide additional capacity along the corridor

MICHIGAN AVE TO ED SULLIVAN DR/43 ST

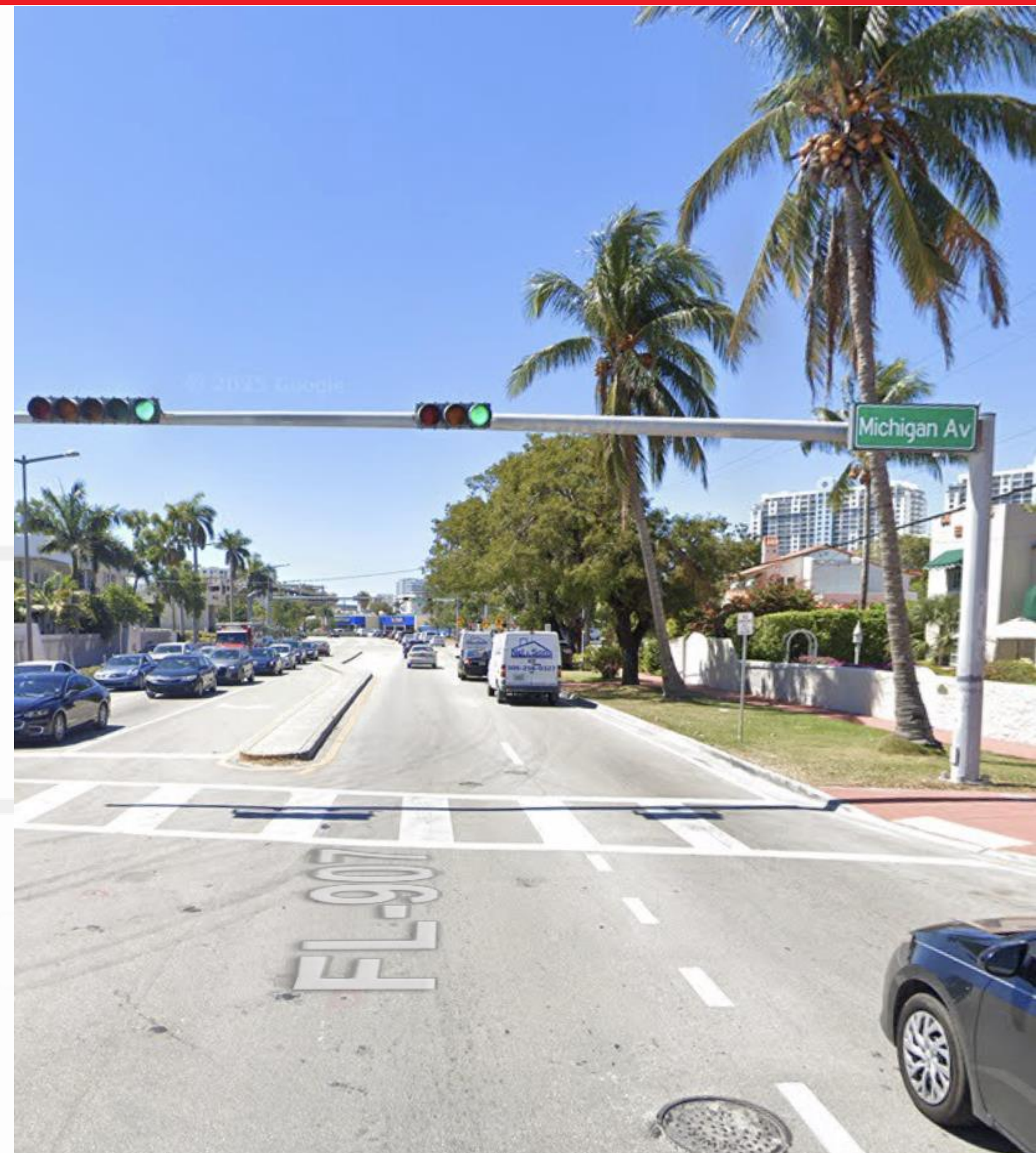
RESILIENCE & RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT – 429193-1

Status

- Design is underway

Project Details

- Improving roadway and drainage
- Changing the roadway elevation for resiliency
- Adding two new pump stations with new inlets and upgrades to the existing drainage
- Widening the northbound lanes towards the golf course to accommodate a bi-direction bicycle facility and sidewalk
- Improving pedestrian signalization and pavement markings
- Adding new lighting along the road





SR 860/MIAMI GARDENS DRIVE

EAST OF SR 93/I-75 TO NW 79 PLACE

RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT – 438864-2

Status

- Design is underway

Project Details

- Widening the road to add one travel lane in each direction
- Adding a shared-use path
- Modifying medians
- Upgrading storm water drainage, lighting, signs and pavement markings
- Adding new signals at major intersections





SR 826/PALMETTO EXPRESSWAY SOUTH

SR 5/US 1/S DIXIE HWY TO NW 25 ST

CAPACITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – 455134 (Segments 1 through 5)

Status

- PD&E is underway
- Project is broken into five phases for funding purposes
- Design is funded for all five segments

Project Details

- Add capacity to mainline and interchanges
- Improving travel time reliability
- Providing long term mobility options





SR 934/NE 79 STREET

PELICAN HARBOR DR TO ADVENTURE AVE

BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT – 449007-2

Status

- Design is underway

Project Details

- Replacing four flat bridges along project limits
- Upgrading curbs and stormwater systems
- Upgrading guardrails
- Upgrading medians along project limits





SR 934/NE/NW 79 ST & 81/82 ST

WEST of I-95 to SR 934/1 WAY

CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS – 410646-5/410646-6

Status

- Design upcoming

Project Details

- Converting one of the three eastbound lanes on NE/NW 79 Street east of I-95 to a westbound lane to provide two lanes in each direction
- Converting NE/NW 81/82 Street to a two-way facility with one westbound lane and one eastbound lane





SR 856/WILLIAM LEHMAN CSWY

SR 5/US 1 to COLLINS AVE

CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – 449745-1

Status

- PD&E upcoming

Project Details

- Accommodating non-motorized activity along the Causeway
- Evaluate providing Shared Use Paths (SUP) and/or similar dedicated bicycle and pedestrian facilities





SR 994/SW 200 ST/ QUAIL ROOST DRIVE

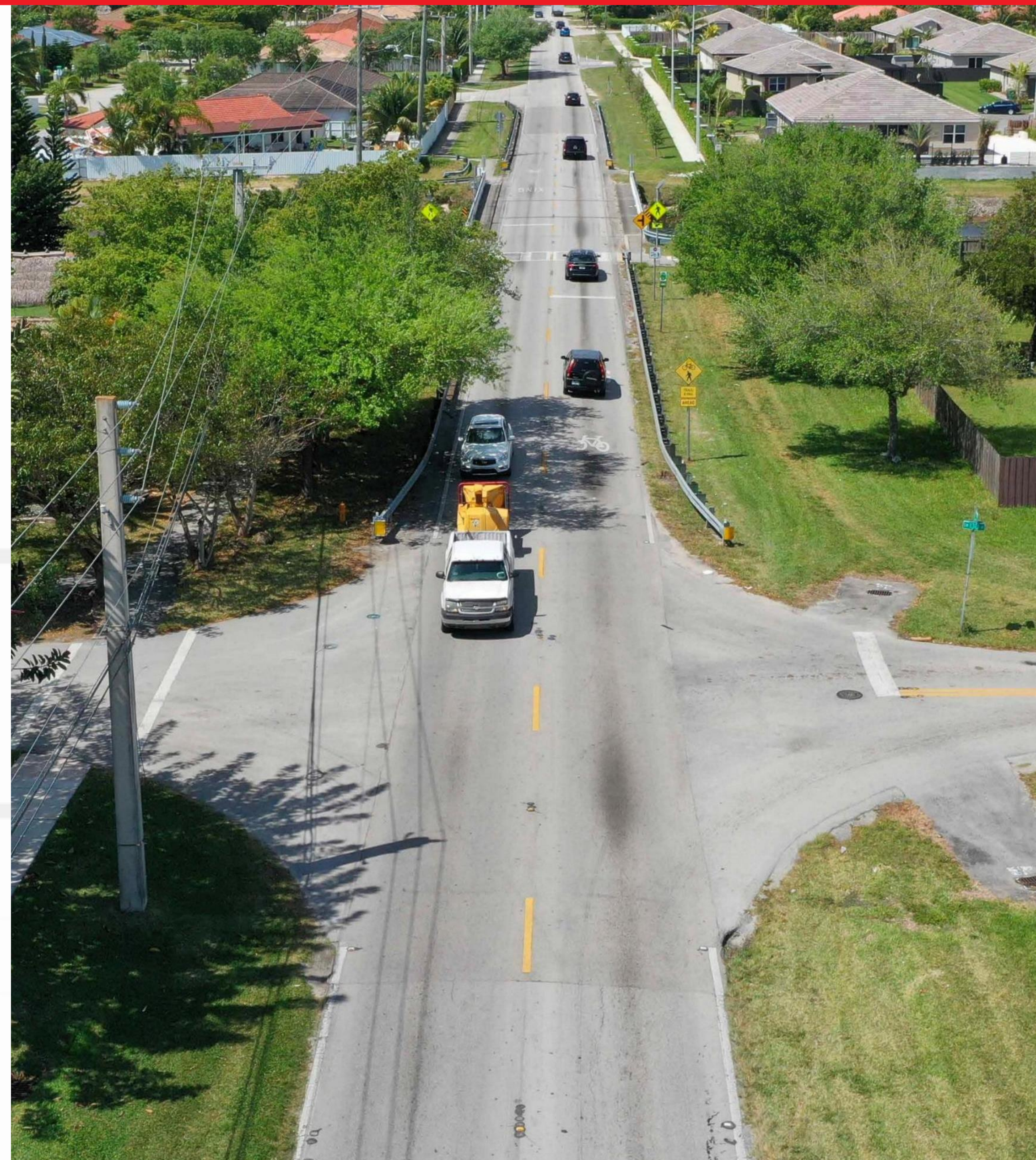
WEST OF SW 137 AVE TO EAST OF SW 127 AVE

Status

- Design is underway

Project Details

- Providing additional capacity to accommodate future travel demand
- Improving multimodal safety conditions
- Enhancing mobility
- Improving emergency evacuation and response/recovery time





SR 25/OKEECHOBEE ROAD

EAST OF NW 116 WAY TO EAST OF NW 87 AVE

RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT – 423251-4

Status

- Design is underway

Project Details

This project will create the envelope for a grade separation of Okeechobee Road by:

- Reconstructing portions of NW 87 Avenue
- Reconstructing portions of State Road 932/NW 103 Street
- Reconstructing portions of South River Drive

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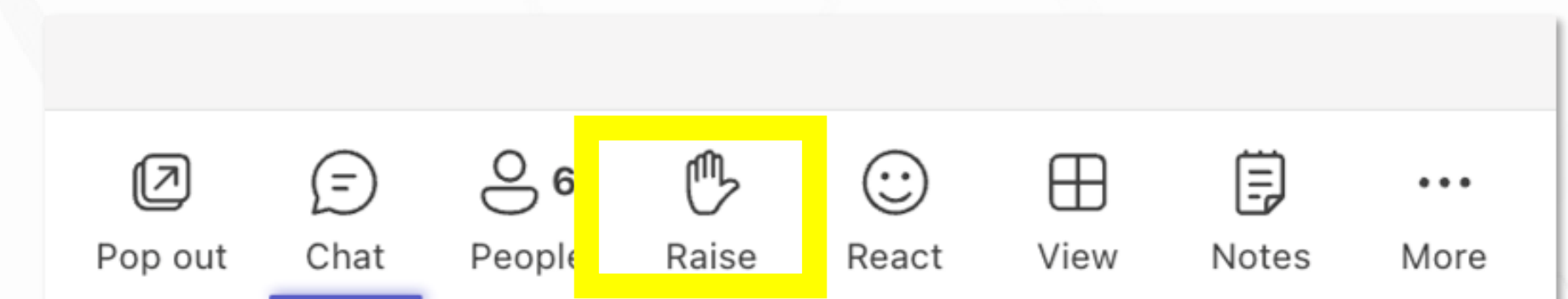


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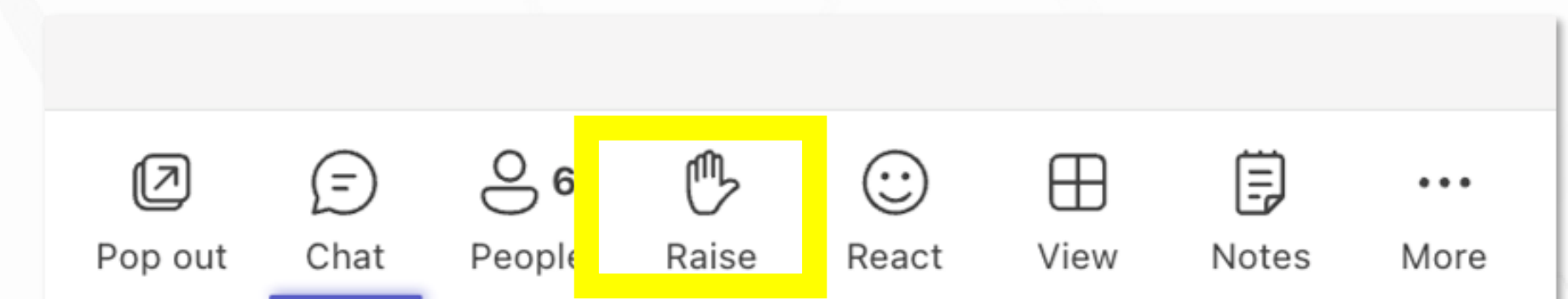
