TENTATIVE WORK PROGRAM CYCLE

Abbreviated Cycle

- JUNE AUGUST: Interact with elected officials. Balances Tentative Work Program to allocations received.
- NOVEMBER/DECEMBER:

Compile District plans to create the Statewide Tentative Work Program. Submit Statewide preliminary draft Tentative Work Program to Governor's Office, Legislature, Florida Transportation Commission and Department of Economic Opportunity.

- **OCTOBER:**
 - Conduct Districtwide Public Hearing and present to sub-committees.

JANUARY:

Florida Transportation Commission (FTC) conducts a statewide public hearing to receive public input for the Tentative Work Program. The Florida Legislature also convenes in January.

Present to Monroe County Board of County Commissioners and Miami-Dade County Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) Governing Board.


After the appropriations are approved by the Legislature, the Work Program is adopted by the FDOT State Secretary.





ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – 454101-1

Status

Design underway

- Repaving and restriping the intersection
- Reconstructing an area of the intersection
- Installing a pump station to minimize flooding









FLORIDA KEYS COASTAL SHORELINE

STABILIZATION PROJECT – 454029-1

Status

Design is underway

- Stabilize the shoreline along SR 5/US 1 in the Florida
 Keys to reduce erosion
- Protect critical transportation infrastructure
- Improve resilience against coastal storms.









KEY WEST INT'L AIRPORT TERMINAL CONCOURSE A

IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – 447911-1

Status

- Construction underway Phase 2
- Expected completion summer 2026

- 50,000 square-foot facility with eight gates
- New pedestrian bridge and new rental car counters
- Designed to withstand 200 miles per hour winds and storm surge

- Offer more mobility options for motorists and transit users
- Provide additional capacity along the corridor


MICHIGAN AVE TO ED SULLIVAN DR/43 ST

RESILIENCE & RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT – 429193-1

Status

Design is underway

- Improving roadway and drainage
- Changing the roadway elevation for resiliency
- Adding two new pump stations with new inlets and upgrades to the existing drainage
- Widening the northbound lanes towards the golf course to accommodate a bi-direction bicycle facility and sidewalk
- Improving pedestrian signalization and pavement markings
- Adding new lighting along the road









SR 860/MIAMI GARDENS DRIVE

EAST OF SR 93/I-75 TO NW 79 PLACE

RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT - 438864-2

Status

Design is underway

- Widening the road to add one travel lane in each direction
- Adding a shared-use path
- Modifying medians
- Upgrading storm water drainage, lighting, signs and pavement markings
- Adding new signals at major intersections









SR 826/PALMETTO EXPRESSWAY SOUTH

SR 5/US 1/S DIXIE HWY TO NW 25 ST

CAPACITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT - 455134 (Segments 1 through 5)

Status

- PD&E is underway
- Project is broken into five phases for funding purposes
- Design is funded for all five segments

- Add capacity to mainline and interchanges
- Improving travel time reliability
- Providing long term mobility options



- Replacing four flat bridges along project limits
- Upgrading curbs and stormwater systems

CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS – 410646-5/410646-6

Status

Design upcoming

- Converting one of the three eastbound lanes on NE/NW 79
 Street east of I-95 to a westbound lane to provide two lanes in each direction
- Converting NE/NW 81/82 Street to a two-way facility with one westbound lane and one eastbound lane

Status

PD&E upcoming

- Accommodating non-motorized activity along the Causeway
- Evaluate providing Shared Use Paths (SUP) and/or similar dedicated bicycle and pedestrian facilities



Design is underway

- Reconstructing portions of State Road 932/NW 103 Street
- Reconstructing portions of South River Drive












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
