

FDOTConnect2023 ProjectWise Managed Workspace Q&A – 11/14/24

Q: Will the PowerPoints be made available from today's webinar?

A: The recording will be available on the website where you registered in about a week.

Q: We had an issue when trying to run CreateFile and it shows CREATEFILEORD is not trusted?

A: That is strange, this typically occurs when a dll or exe is downloaded from the internet outside of the installer (Windows security blocks it). My first suggestion would be have your PW Admin checkout the 4 dll files located in the FDOTConnect2023\Organization-Civil\FDOT\Apps\CreateFile folder. Once checked out local, right click on EACH file and select "Properties", you will probably see a check box labeled "unblock", check that box, hit OK. Once done for each dll file, check them back in. If this does not work submit a support ticket and we can do a Teams meeting and take a look.

Q: All of those files do NOT show that option, so they are already set, maybe setup a support ticket? Is that a Bentley Support?

A: I'll get with Buddy and see if he's seen that before. I have your email from past correspondence and get back with you .

Q: I assume you meant the files under the PWDrive folder, yes?

A: Do you have your Workspace sync'd to PWDrive? If not, those files would be in the BMS folder.

Q: What installation will we need to execute? and where can we find it? Or will there be instructions on how to configure for PW manually?

A: You can download the Server install, install it to any location to basically just extract the files. Then copy the FDOT2023 folder into ProjectWise (Buddy may go other this later).

Q: Could you up your mic volume? I have my speaker maxed out but it's still very soft.

A: Mine is very high with volume set at half volume.

Q: For the CADD QC does it have to be a managed workspace to work with Projectwise or will it find the files in PW if it's a local install? Looks like the other apps

would if they're using MS config variables but the workset root wouldn't be on PW in that scenario while the files actually would.

A: QC (from managed or un-managed workspace) can only process files that can be found thru File Explorer, so if your files are stored in PW you have to either use PWDrive (as I showed in the video) or the files need to be exported out of PW to a local/network location.
