## TRAFFIC SIGNS AND REGULATIONS

MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS  
Interstate and Four Lane Divided Highways with a Minimum of 20 Foot Median:  
Cars 70  
Trucks and Combinations 65  
House Trailers 60  
Towpucks 60

Cars 70  
Trucks and Combinations 65  
House Trailers 60

FLORIDA SCHOOL BUS LAW  
All traffic must STOP when school buses are loading or unloading except when State or Federal law allows a divided highway which has an unpaired space of 5 feet or more or a physical barrier between the roadways.

HEADLIGHTS  
Headlights (not Parking Lights) must be used between the hours of Sunset and Sunrise and at other times when rain or fog reduce vision to 500 feet or less.

FLORIDA PAVEMENT MARKINGS

DO NOT PASS IF A SOLID LINE IS ON YOUR SIDE.	SINGLE SOLID LINE IS USED TO INDICATE NO PASSING STREAMS OF TRAFFIC.	PASS ONLY IF BROKEN LINE IS ON YOUR SIDE.
