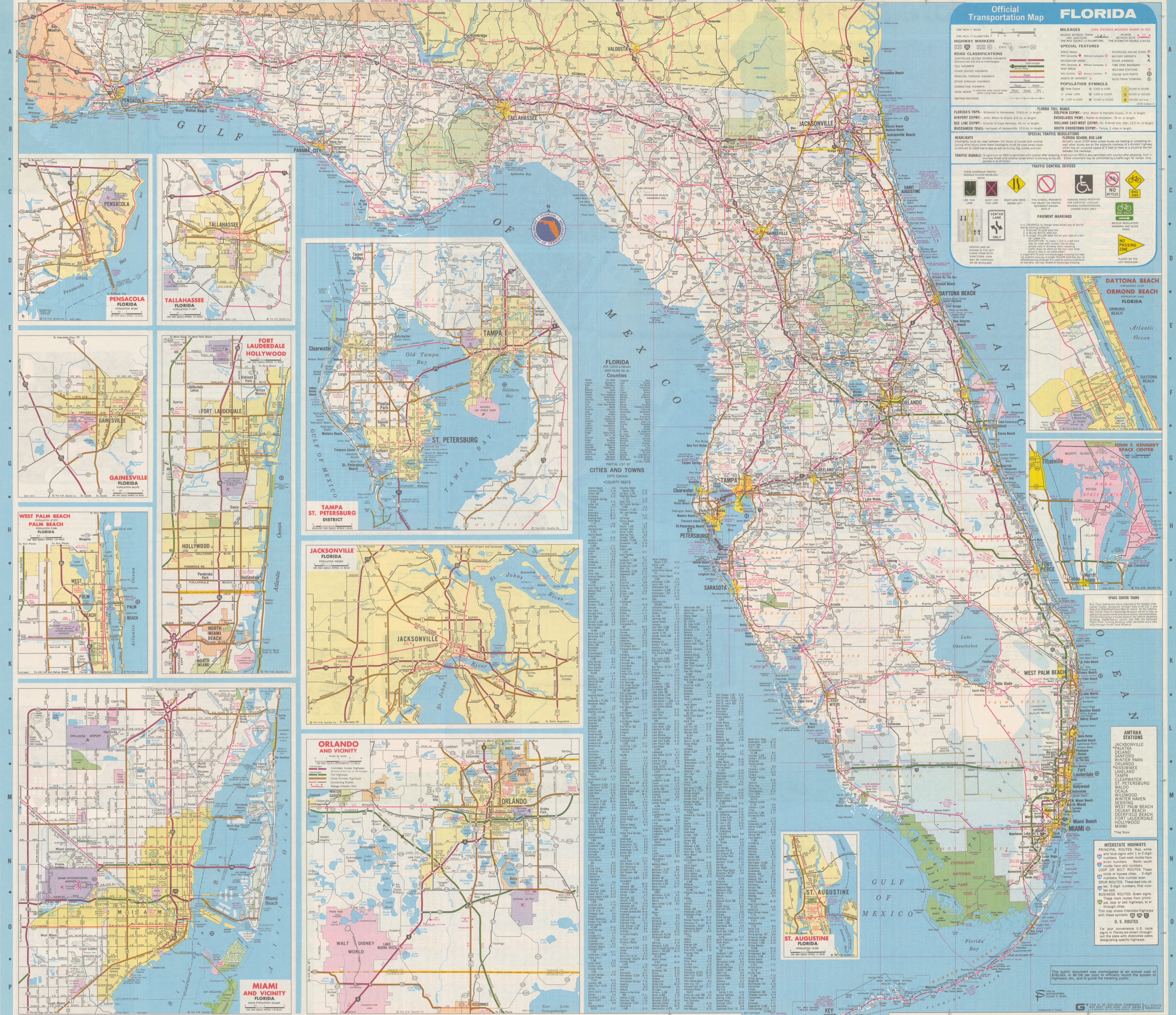

SPECIAL REGULATIONS
 FLORIDA SCHOOL BUS LAW
 ADULTS MUST STOP when school buses are loading or unloading
 except when buses are on the opposite roadway of a divided highway
 which has an unobstructed view of at least 500 feet of roadway on
 both sides of the road.

TRAFFIC SIGNALS - A right turn on RED is permitted with caution after stopping. A left turn on RED is also permitted with caution after stopping, from a
 position other than the left lane on a one-way street. Other movement may be permitted by a traffic sign for certain
 periods of all times.

INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS
 PRINCIPAL ROUTES: Red, white and blue signs with 1 or 2-digit numbers. East-west routes have even numbers. North-south routes have odd numbers. LOOP or BETT ROUTES: These circle or bypass cities. 3-digit numbers: First number: even or odd. SpUR ROUTES: These lead into city. 3-digit numbers: First number: bar or odd. BUSINESS ROUTES: Green signs. These mark routes from principal, loop or belt highways, to or through cities.
