I retired in August of 2018, with 47 years' experience in Construction/Engineering, with my last 30 years dedicated exclusively to FDOT, both as an FDOT and CEI Manager. I completed DRB Member Training in 2004 and was actively involved in the DRB process since the early 1990's, when FDOT added this program. I can assure Construction Teams of my commitment to approach selection on DRB's with the same dedication and integrity that I approached any position. In addition, I clearly understand the role of the Board to encourage the timely documentation and resolution of issues at the Project level, with escalation up the chain of command, while being prepared to impartially evaluate the merits of disputes that may be elevated to the Board for evaluation.

Major Area of Experience Include:

- Fifteen years of direct project management on road, bridge, and toll projects.
- Management of an annual construction work program of up to \$400 M, as Turnpike Construction Engineer
