Rules For Escalation

If the parties can't agree on an issue, then escalate.

If the parties can't agree on "what" the issue is, then escalate.

If the parties can't agree on a plan of action to resolve the issue, then escalate.

If the parties do not have the authority to resolve the issue, then escalate.

If there is a lack of response from the other party involved, then escalate.

² Escalate to this level on Cost OR Time issues greater than the limits shown below OR if the issue will be referred to the DRB:

Cost > \$150,000 per issue.

Time > The cumulative maximum of 30 days or 5% of the original contract time, whichever is greater.
