SUBJECT: CPAM PROPOSED REVISIONS - CHAPTER 10 AND MISCELLANEOUS REVISIONS

The Comments/Responses along with the Redline/Strikeout version of the proposed changes from the annual review of Chapter 10 are attached for your review. These proposed revisions will be voted on in the April 3, 2000 teleconference. Additional changes to be incorporated with these revisions will be:

In Chapter 2, Section 3, Page 2-3-4, line 6 - 16, the Contractor-s Monthly Summary of Wage Rates, Form No. 600-000-06, has been revised to Contractors' Annual Project Summary of Wage Rates, Form No. 700-010-95. Lines 7 - 16 gives the distribution of this form. The revised form can still be found on the DOT web page under the Estimates Office, Engineering Support Services, Wage Rates within the next few months this form will be moved to Construction Offices web page.

In Chapter 3, Section 2 there was a necessary change on Attachment 3-2-1, a copy of this change is attached. On Attachment 3-2-1 (at project completion) in 3.f was deleted for clarification purposes. Reference Construction Memorandum No. 01-00.

In Chapter 3, Section 3, Page 3-3-1, line 5, the word all was inserted, the word construction was deleted and (construction or maintenance) was inserted at the end of the sentence. On page 3-3-3, line 27 and 28 the correct title was inserted for the Final Estimates Review and Administration Manual and the incorrect title was deleted.

In Chapter 5, Section 6, Page 5-6-2, lines 18 and 19 a revision was made to paragraph titled Delinquent Contract. The definition was changed to read "The allowed contract time for performing the work has expired and the Contractor has not completed the contract work." Refer to Construction Bulletin No. 01-00, dated January 26, 2000.
