**SUBJECT: DISCONTINUATION OF THE CONTRACTOR'S ANNUAL
PROJECT SUMMARY OF WAGES COLLECTION**

The requirement for the collection of the Contractor's Annual Project Summary of Wages Form (700-010-95) is discontinued. This is being done in an effort to move to a voluntary form of wage data collection. All forms that have been collected up until this time should be forwarded to the Prevailing Wage Rate Coordinator in the State Construction Office.

The US Department of Labor will be conducting wage surveys in the future and will announce data collection times. Florida has been tentatively scheduled to be surveyed in the next 2 years. All contractors should be encouraged to participate in these surveys as participation levels dictate the accuracy of the data collected and therefore the accuracy of the newly published wage tables.

Information of collection method and procedures for the survey will be disseminated closer to the time of the survey period.
