SUBJECT: COMPACTING AND FINISHING BASE

The Earthwork Technical Advisory Committee highlighted an issue in the Reclaimed Asphalt Pavement Base Specification that needs to be corrected.

Please process a \$0.00 specification change on contracts let in the month of July 2002 through July 2003. Contracts let in the month of July 2003 and thereafter will have the revised specification language included in the Contract.

The Specification change is as follows:

Sub-article 283-4.1(of the Supplemental Specifications) is deleted and the following substituted:

283-4.1 General: Meet the requirements of 200-6.1

Additionally, the following is also changed as follows:

Sub-article 283-4.4(of the Supplemental Specifications) is deleted and the following substituted:

283-4.4 Density Tests: Meet the requirements of 200-7 with the exception of 200-7.2.1. Within the entire limits of the width and depth of the base, obtain a minimum density in any LOT of 95% of the maximum density as determined by FM 1-T 180.

This memorandum serves as a blanket approval to process a specification change and should be attached to the Field Supplemental Agreement/Work Order or the Supplemental Agreement.
