SUBJECT: 334-4, ACCEPTANCE OF THE MIXTURE AT THE PLANT

In order to simplify the Contractor Quality Control process for contract with small quantity of hot mix asphalt, please process a \$ 0.00 specification change, as applicable, **for contracts let starting in July 2002 through June 2003**. Contracts let in July 2003 and thereafter will have the revised language included in the contract.

The Specification change is as follows:

SUBARTICLE 334-4.1 (of the Supplemental Specifications) is expanded as follows:

When the total quantity of any mix type is less than 500 tons [500 metric tons], the Engineer will accept the mix on the basis of visual inspection. The Engineer may run (or require the Contractor to run) tests for informational purposes; however, these tests will not be used as a basis for payment.

This memorandum serves as a blanket approval to process a specification change and should be attached to the Field Supplemental Agreement/Work Order or the Supplemental Agreement.
