Due to recent shortages in the supply of aggregates and its impacts on construction projects, please process a \$0.00 specification change for all active contracts. The specification change is as follows:

Subarticle 334-3.2.1 General, Insert the following sentence before the last sentence of the first paragraph:

During the progress of the work, if an unusual shortage of aggregates is encountered at the project and the condition is beyond the reasonable control of the Contractor and could not have been reasonably anticipated or mitigated, the Engineer, in his sole discretion, may allow the use of an additional mix design; however such allowance shall be at no additional cost or time to the Department.

This modification is in conjunction with the efforts of the CQC Specification Revision Task Team.
