SUBJECT: Sampling of FC-5 Asphalt Mixtures

In order to address some isolated problems associated with the sampling of FC-5 mixtures as described in FM 1-T 168 (Sampling Bituminous Paving Mixtures), the following steps should be taken:

1. The sampling and splitting process should be accomplished as quickly as possible to reduce loss of temperature and minimize binder draindown.
2. During the splitting process, the tools used to split the sample should be heated to reduce adherence of binder and fines.
3. The boxes used to store samples for FC-5 (for Verification and Resolution purposes) should be silicone coated on the interior, similar to those from the Menasha Corporation, to facilitate recovery of the binder in cases where there is binder draindown and/or excessive binder adhesion to the box.
4. Since there are no G_{mb} or G_{mm} specimens required for FC-5 mix, the amount of material sampled can be reduced. The amount of material required for Verification and Resolution purposes can be reduced from three to two boxes.
