SUBJECT: **Specification Change for Granitic Coarse Aggregate -
Maximum Percent Passing the Minus 200 Sieve**

Pending a Specification change, the Total Material passing the No. 200 [75 µm] sieve (FM 1-T 011) for Granitic Coarse Aggregate is hereby changed to a maximum of 2.50 percent at an Aggregate Source. This Source could be a Mine or Redistribution Terminal that is the last destination from which the aggregate is shipped to a point of use.

Please process a \$0.00 specification change for current contracts to delete the seventh item of deleterious materials in Section 901-1.2, "At Source1.75", and replace it with the following (the change is identified by bold text):

At Non-Granitic Source..... 1.75
At Granitic Source 2.50

This memorandum serves as a blanket approval to process this change and should be attached to the Field Supplemental Agreement/Work Order or Supplemental Agreement.
