Specification Change for Granitic Coarse Aggregate -

Maximum Percent Passing the Minus 200 Sieve

Pending a Specification change, the Total Material passing the No. 200 [75  $\mu$ m] sieve (FM 1-T 011) for Granitic Coarse Aggregate is hereby changed to a maximum of 2.50 percent at an Aggregate Source. This Source could be a Mine or Redistribution Terminal that is the last destination from which the aggregate is shipped to a point of use.

At Non-Granitic Source1	.75
At Granitic Source	.50
