This DCE Memorandum supersedes DCE Memorandum 21-06 dated October 16, 2006. This applies to all projects let under the 2004 Standard Specifications with Supplemental Specification 0051441SS and also for any current projects let under the 2007 Standard

The Department has revised Standard Specification 5-12.2.2 Claims For Delay. A specification revision is being completed by the State Specification Office, but the revision should be implemented as soon as possible on all applicable projects. Specification 5-12.2.2 references subarticle 4-3.2.1(c) or 4-3.2(c), but should be replaced with 4-3.2.1(a) and (c).

The Department has revised Standard Specification 5-12.6.2.1 Compensation for Direct Costs, Indirect Costs, Expenses and Profit thereon, of or from Delay. A specification revision is being completed by the State Specification Office, but the revision should be implemented as soon as possible on all applicable projects. Specification 5-12.6.2.1 references subarticle 4-3.2(d), but should be replaced with 4-3.2.1(d).
