SUBJECT: ELECTRONIC FINAL "AS-BUILT" PLANS

BACKGROUND:

In an effort to improve upon our business practices within the Department, to become more efficient, the traditional Computation Book was eliminated for lettings starting July 2014. All planned and final quantities are to be recorded within the Plan Set, in the Plan Summary Boxes. With this process change, the State Construction Office looked at the need to carry forward additional efficiency gains and convert to a paperless environment. The evaluation resulted in the need to shift towards electronic Final "As-Built" Plans.

CONSTRUCTION IMPLEMENTATION:

In an effort to go paperless, all Final As-Built plan sets will be marked up electronically, in accordance with the revised Chapter 5.12 "Final "As-Built" Plans Process", of the Construction Project Administration Manual. This requirement is effective for all construction projects with July 2015 lettings.
