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

**SUBJECT: CPAM REVISION – CHAPTER 7, SECTION 2/SECTION 7.2.7
CONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE**

In order to clarify when time charges are to stop for Lighting and Signalization projects, the following additional changes to Chapter 7, Section 2 of CPAM as it pertains to Section 7.2.7 Conditional Acceptance is to be made.

Add to paragraph (2):

“Time can only stop on lighting and signalization projects when all other work, including punch list work, has been fully completed.”

Add paragraph (4):

“When the Project Engineer sends the contractor a letter stating the project is Conditionally Accepted, the Project Engineer is to advise the Contractor whether or not Time is stopped. A copy of this letter is to be sent to the District Construction Office for their appropriate action.”

The above additions are made to separate the **TIME** issue from **CONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE** of specialized projects. Present contracts only allows conditional acceptance on movable bridges.
