- Introduction of TRT Chairmen – Chairmen introduced themselves
- TRT quarterly meetings minute review – good with minutes
- TRT membership
 - Aim for 5 member per TRT

 - ask for assistance in recruiting TRT members (Concrete)
- Inclusion of call-in number on TRT agendas
- Establish requirements for Instructors
 - Must Instructor have CTQP Qualification in subject area?
 - QCM has qualification and if not approved if they have not
 - Concrete must have years of experience
 - Asphalt must have years of experience and have knowledge of subject
 - Aggregate must have knowledge
 - Earthwork must have knowledge and preform training, must have experience.
 - Must Instructor maintain CTQP Qualification in subject area? No
- Establish requirements for Providers
 - Ownership of required equipment (access or owner)? Ownership is not required
 - Earthwork might be different due to live source site in density
 - Equipment, models or actual equipment?
 - Leave up to individual TRT
 - Depends on equipment and complexity of the equipment.
 - Have this question on next meeting to determine if “modules” have been submitted previously.
