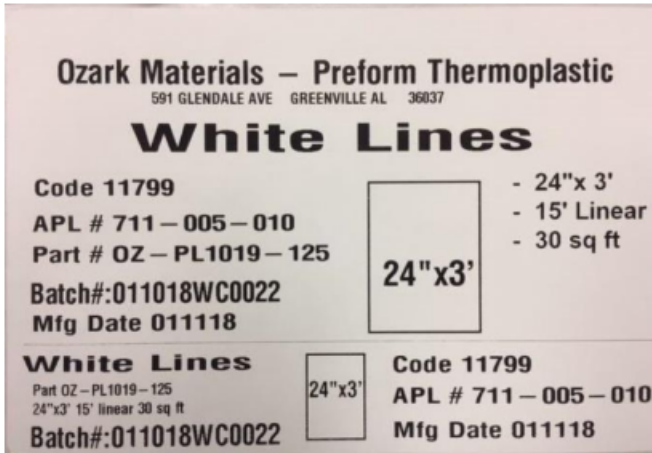
**SUBJECT: PAVEMENT MARKING MATERIAL CERTIFICATION**

The Department specifications currently require material certifications be submitted to the Engineer with the APL number and the batch or Lot numbers for the following pavement marking material Specifications:

- 701 – Profiled Thermoplastic Pavement Markings
- 709 – Two Reactive Components Pavement Markings
- 710 – Painted Pavement Markings
- 711 – Thermoplastic Pavement Markings

Language for each of these specifications is currently states, “Notify the Engineer prior to the placement of the materials. At the time of notification, submit a certification to the Engineer with the APL number and the batch or Lot numbers of the....” materials.

**Specification 971-1.1 Packaging and Labeling** requires the name and address of the manufacturer be shown on the label. The label must also show the color, date of manufacturer, lot number and APL number. An example of this requirement is shown below for reference.



The Department will now allow 701, 709, and 711 materials with labels as shown above to be provided for pavement marking materials that meet the requirements of 971-1.1 without providing material certifications. This material acceptance memorandum does **NOT** apply to Specification 710 Painted Pavement Markings as it will still require material certifications.

**This memorandum serves as a blanket approval to process a \$0.00 contract change to accept products noted when labeled as shown above and should be attached to the Work Order or Supplemental Agreement for all active contracts that include pay items in Specifications 701, 709 and 711.**
