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SUBJECT: REVISED PROCUREMENT AND CONTRACTOR'S QUALITY

CONTROL PLAN REQUIREMENTS OF SPECIFIC STRUCTURAL

MATERIALS FOR PROJECTS LET AFTER JULY 1, 2024

The Department has updated Table 1 of the **FDOT FY24-25 Materials Manual – Chapter 11.1 Fabrication Inspection and Testing of Structural Metal Products – Volume II**. To ensure the efficiency of the construction schedules and materials supply chain, the following elements are no longer required to be produced by a Department approved facility or listed in Contractor's Quality Control Plans:

- Stairs
- Stay-In-Place Forms (with Polymer coating)
- Stay-In-Place Forms (without Polymer coating)
- Laminated Bearing Pads
- Ancillary Bearing Pads
- Steel Mast Arm
- Steel Strain Pole
- Steel CCTV Pole
- Aluminum J-Arms

- Aluminum Light Poles
- Steel Mast Lighting (High Mast Lighting, Conventional Lighting)
- Steel Railing
- Aluminum Railing
- Drainage (Welded gratings, inlets, frames)
- Drainage (Cast manhole, grating, inlets, frames)
- Coated Steel Fence (Aluminized, PVC, Powder)
- Galvanizing
- Powder Coating

For Projects with letting dates before 7/1/2024, this memorandum serves as a blanket approval to process a \$0.00 contract change to accept these materials and should be attached to the Work Order or Supplemental Agreement.

Projects with letting dates after 7/1/2024 should not list these items in the Contractor's Quality Control Plan in MAC at all and the project should follow the current requirements of the FDOT FY24-25 Materials Manual – Chapter 11.1 Fabrication Inspection and Testing of Structural Metal Products – Volume II.
