SUBJECT: PROJECT INFORMATION SIGNS

In an effort to reduce distracted driving and improve jobsite safety, the Roadway Design Office recently released <u>ROADWAY DESIGN BULLETIN 20-01: Project Information Signs</u>. This Bulletin goes into effect for all projects with lettings on or after July 1, 2020 and removes the requirement for the installation of Project Information Signs on construction projects.

In coordination with this Bulletin, contractors are directed to remove all Project Information Signs from all active construction projects. For any projects requiring the use of Project Information Signs in the Plans, with lettings prior to July 1, 2020, these signs shall not be installed. Since payment for Project Information Signs is included under lump sum Maintenance of Traffic, no contract or payment changes are necessary. The requirements of this bulletin are effective immediately.
