



 - DVACs will need to be present.





Filtering



Filtering can be done on items such

as change orders, DWRs, and diaries.





Upgrade to PrC v4.8.2

- PrC v4.8.2 in Systest has been installed and has been tested by Construction.
- Pre-Construction, Estimating, and Maintenance are still conducting testing.
- Possible upgrade is now scheduled March 5 or later.





Change Orders showing 'Read Only' Errors

- Some users are reporting an issue with COs returning an error upon saving that shows a 'Read Only' error.
- This issue has been resolved.
- Should you experience a 'Read Only' error when attempting to approve a change order.
- Please report the contract id and change order number to the System Section for review if error occurs.








Stockpile Information

Stockpile Information — Transfer from PTS






Manually negate stockpile entries to "load" stockpile from Payltem Tracking System (PTS). Then stockpile will deplete as material is installed automatically.

Does not work. System Section will work with Infotech.






Sublet Information

Incorrect percent removed from screen.


Correct (from report) percentage will be added soon.
