

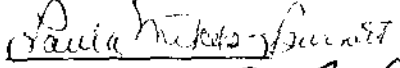
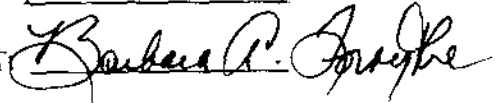


**CERTIFICATE OF INCUMBENCY AND AUTHORITY**

I, (Barbara A. I do further certify that the foregoing authority shall remain in full force and effect, and said **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STATE OF FLORIDA** shall be entitled to rely upon same, until written notice of the modification, rescission or revocation of same, in whole or in part, has been delivered to said **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STATE OF FLORIDA** but no such modification, rescission or revocation shall, in any event, be effective with respect to any documents executed or actions taken in reliance upon the foregoing authority prior to the delivery to said **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STATE OF FLORIDA** written notice of said modification, rescission or revocation. (The City of Lake Worth, Florida) hereby waives the company seal on all documents signed by the representative, and agrees to be bound as fully as if the company seal were affixed. Attached is a corporative action or resolution to this effect.

RESOLUTION NO. 31-96 OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF UTILITIES RELOCATION MASTER AGREEMENTS FOR THE ADJUSTMENT, CHANGE OR RELOCATION OF CERTAIN UTILITIES WITHIN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LIMITS OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM; EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Department proposes to engage in certain projects for constructing, reconstructing or otherwise changing a portion of the State Highway System, which shall call for the location, protection, and/or relocation and adjustment of the City of Lake Worth utilities on said Projects; and

WHEREAS, the plans for the said construction, reconstruction or other changes are to be reviewed by the State of Florida Department of Transportation and the City of Lake Worth; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has presented the City of Lake Worth with Utilities Relocation Master Agreements to circumvent the current necessity of processing a separate agreement for each individual state highway project involving City of Lake Worth utilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation a Utilities Relocation Master Agreement (at the Department's Expense) and a Utilities Relocation Master Agreement (at the Utilities Owner's Expense).

Section 2. A certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the State of Florida Department of Transportation at Tallahassee, Florida.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

The passage of this Resolution was moved by Commissioner Ramiccio, seconded by Commissioner Clager, and upon being put a vote, the vote was as follows:
