UTILITY RELOCATION MASTER AGREEMENT
(As Amended)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN UTILITIES RELOCATION MASTER AGREEMENT FOR THE ADJUSTMENT, CHANGE OR RELOCATION OF CERTAIN UTILITIES LOCATED ON PROPERTY IN WHICH THE CITY HAS NO COMPENSABLE INTEREST, AND PROVIDING WHEN THE SUBJECT RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, 82-3

ON MOTION OF Commissioner (Name) Free (last name) recognized by the following Resolution was adopted.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation proposes to engage in maintenance, reconstruction, or other change of portions of the State Highway System;

AND WHEREAS, in order for the State of Florida Department of Transportation to complete said projects, it may be necessary that certain utilities and facilities located on property in which the City has no compensable interest be relocated, removed or reconstructed;

AND WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation having requested the City of NEW PORT RICHEY to execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation an Utilities Relocation Master Agreement, agreeing to relocate, adjust, change or relocate certain utilities and facilities as set forth in the attached specifications for such project and conditions, which have been duly considered;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the CITY COUNCIL of the City of NEW PORT RICHEY, Florida, that the Mayor and City Manager be and they are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation and Utilities Relocation Master Agreement for the adjustment, change or relocation of certain utilities and facilities located on property in which the City has no compensable interest.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the State of Florida Department of Transportation for its use and filing.
