A RESOLUTION  
TO BE ENTITLED:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A UTILITIES RELOCATION MASTER AGREEMENT FOR THE ADJUSTMENT, CHANGE OR RELOCATION OF CERTAIN UTILITIES WHERE LOCATED ON PROPERTY IN WHICH THE CITY HAS NO COMPENSABLE INTEREST, AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation proposes to engage in certain projects for construction, reconstruction or other change of portions of the State Highway System;

AND WHEREAS, in order for the State of Florida Department of Transportation to complete said projects, it may be necessary that certain utilities and facilities located on property in which the City holds no compensable interest be adjusted, changed or relocated;

AND WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation having requested the City of Pensacola, Florida, to execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation a Utilities Relocation Master Agreement, agreeing to make or cause to be made such adjustments, changes or relocation of said utilities and facilities as set forth in the plans and specifications for that project, and said request having been duly considered;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pensacola Florida;

SECTION 1. That the City Manager and Administrator-City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation a Utilities Relocation Master Agreement for the adjustment, change or other relocation of utilities and facilities located on property in which the City holds no compensable interest.

SECTION 2. A certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the State of Florida Department of Transportation at Tallahassee, Florida.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council and shall be published as required by law.
