A RESOLUTION APPROVING A MASTER AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR UTILITY RELOCATION FOR HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
