SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION – PAVEMENT TYPE SELECTION MANUAL
JUNE 1, 2005 UPDATE

The changes in pavement type selection requirements are to be implemented as follows:

SUMMARY OF CHANGES:

Pavement Type Selection Analyses are now also required on high volume resurfacing projects where there is a history of poor performance.

Life cycle cost analyses are to be summarized on a project mile basis and to include design, MOT and CEI costs. The QC checklist in Appendix A has been expanded. A new economic analysis format has been added to Appendix C for district specific scenarios that have been documented for similar facilities.

Copies of all approved pavement type selection analyses are to be sent to the Central Pavement Management Section for QA review purposes.

IMPLEMENTATION:

Implementation should be as soon as practical without impacting current production schedules.
