This Work Document Driven Contract consists of furnishing all labor, equipment, materials, maintenance of traffic, and incidentals necessary to perform interstate vegetation management operations within the Lake City Operations Area in Baker, Columbia, Hamilton, Madison, and Suwannee Counties. Work includes selective clearing and grubbing of interstate roadway right of ways on I-10 and I-75 to include cutting, removal, and disposal of trees, brush, stumps, roots, and other objectionable materials; grinding of stumps; and removal and disposal of all resulting debris as directed by the work document. Perform stump grinding to the required depth below finished grade; backfilling and restoration of disturbed areas to match existing grades; proper disposal of all materials are incidental to the selective clearing and grubbing pay item, and no burning of debris allowed on state right-of-way. Coordination with other projects will be required at no additional cost to the Department and etc.
