The Scope of Services for the Asset Maintenance Contract for Okaloosa County and a portion of Walton County shall be amended as follows:

- **Attachment I of the Asset Maintenance Scope of Services is replaced with the revised Attachment I dated 2-14-2018.**
  
- **Section 4.1 of the Asset Maintenance Scope of Services is deleted and replaced with the following new section 4.1**

### **4.1 MID-BAY SYSTEM MAINTENANCE**

Maintain all components of the Mid-Bay System as defined in the Department's Amended and Restated Lease-Purchase Agreement dated May 19, 2015, and as may be updated throughout the life of the contract. Maintenance responsibilities exclude all toll facility maintenance as further detailed in the Department's Standard Written Agreement No. BE190. These documents are provided on the Contract Proposal Processing Online Ordering System.

In addition to the standard MRP scores (Overall, Elements, and Characteristics) detailed in the Roadway and Roadside Maintenance procedure that apply to the State Highway System, the Florida Transportation Commission has established certain amplified MRP performance measures applicable to toll authorities. Maintain MRP scores in accordance with MRP performance measure objectives established by the Commission, and as may be updated throughout the life of the contract.

For MRP evaluation purposes this contract is divided into two regions: 1) the Mid-Bay System and 2) the State Highway System. The State Highway System includes all State roads covered by this contract excluding the Mid-Bay System. Each region will receive its own set of random sample points, be evaluated separately, and receive its own set of MRP evaluation scores. The Mid-Bay System will be programmed to receive more random MRP evaluation locations than a road its length would typically receive, and it must achieve the higher MRP evaluation scores as established by the Florida Transportation Commission. The Department will perform an MRP rating three times per year for each region utilizing the methods outlined in Section 3 "Maintenance Rating Program Performed by the Department". Required MRP ratings and any associated deductions detailed in this section for the Mid-Bay System govern over those referenced in Section 3 "Maintenance Rating Program Performed by the Department". Retainage and deductions for failure to achieve MRP score requirements on the State Highway System portion will be calculated per the MRP Scores performance measures chart in Section 3 of this Scope. Deductions for failure to achieve MRP score requirements on the Mid-Bay System portion will be calculated at the time of each Final Annual MRP rating and will be assessed in

accordance with the MRP Scores – Mid-Bay System performance measures chart contained in this section.

Current enhanced MRP performance measures as established by the Commission are detailed below and apply only to the Mid-Bay System:

**Overall MRP Rating**

Achieve a score of 90 or higher.

**Signs**

Maintain an individual characteristic rating of 90 or better. Calculation of the MRP score for this measure will be computed by averaging the MRP score for both sign groups.

**Striping**

Maintain an individual characteristic rating of 95 or better.

**Guardrail**

Maintain an individual characteristic rating of 80 or better.

**Lighting**

Maintain an individual characteristic rating of 85 or better.
