3. ASSET MAINTENANCE PERFORMANCE MEASURES

AM Contractor will be held accountable for any enhanced or higher standard presented by the AM Contractor in its Technical Proposal with respect to the deduction tables below. The enhanced or higher standard becomes the new performance standard for the contract.

MRP notes: The Department will hold the retainage withheld from MRP periods 1 & 2 until the Department calculates the final annual MRP rating. If the final annual calculated deduction is less than the total accumulated retainage for the fiscal year, the balance of the retainage will be paid to the Contractor. If the final annual calculated deduction exceeds the total accumulated retainage for the fiscal year, the balance will be deducted from the Contractor's payment. All deductions withheld from the Contractor and all retainage refunds to the Contractor will occur through adjustments to subsequent monthly invoice(s). Current Department procedures override this chart.
