1. Bid Extension requested to November 7, 2024. Granted.

- There are multiple references to the timeline required per A-21, but there is not a timeline shown. Will we be submitting a proposed schedule after contract award? Once Notice to Proceed has been received a pre-work meeting will be scheduled and you will be asked to submit proposed schedule and Schedule of Values.
- 3. Can the contract be amended to cap liquidated damages at 100% of the contract value? Unfortunately, we will not be able to cap liquidated damages at 100% of the contract value, we will need to follow A-23 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES in the Non-Technical Specifications.
- 4. I saw this for time of completion. Based on current material lead times and expected installation times, I don't think we could meet this schedule. A more realistic time is 260 days. Because of the material lead time the departments will agree to give 255 calendar days for substantial completion and final completion within 10 calendar days after substantial completion.
