4.26 Pavement Marking Maintenance Plan

Develop and implement a pavement marking maintenance plan to address missing Raised Pavement Markers (RPM) and non-retroreflective pavement marking. Include details in the plan on how the Contractor will ensure that for any one location, defined as one (1) mile in a single direction of travel, there is no more than 100 feet of continuous centerline or lane line without a reflective marker, and no more than 528 continuous feet of non-reflective pavement marking.

Pavement Marking Maintenance Plan Performance Criteria

Deficiency Identification	Time Allowed/Criteria	Deduction
Failure to implement the pavement marking maintenance plan to replace missing or defective RPMs.	Within 30 days of identification.	\$ 3,000 per identified location
Failure to implement the pavement marking maintenance plan to address non-retroreflective pavement marking.	Within 30 days of identification.	\$ 3,000 per identified location
