Proposers and other interested parties are informed that the above-referenced Project documents are hereby revised, changed, and supplemented as set forth below.

**I. REVISION # 1**

The Request for Proposal, Section VI, Subsection N, Signing and Pavement Marking Plans, has been revised. The following text has been added at the end of the section:

**Wrong-Way Arrow Pavement Markings and RPMs**

- RPMs shall *only* be installed in conjunction with Wrong-Way Arrow pavement markings located on Interchange Exit Ramps.
- RPMs shall no longer be installed with Wrong-Way Arrow pavement markings on Arterial or Collector roadways.

**Wrong-Way and Do Not Enter Sign Orientation Adjustment**

- All WRONG WAY (R5-1a) and DO NOT ENTER (R5-1) signs installed in conjunction with Wrong-Way Arrow pavement markings shall be rotated 45 degrees toward the direction of the intended regulation, improving visibility to errant drivers entering the ramp in the wrong direction.

**II. REVISION # 2**
