Answer: The locations requiring 0570-1-2 are between the proposed EOP and existing or proposed sidewalk and therefore does not adjoin to private lawns. There is one section where we are putting drainage structures behind the proposed sidewalk and we call for 0570-1-1 in this area which will adjoin to private properties. That is roughly from STA 170+00 to 183+00 on the left. Please refer to Specifications Section 570, Performance Turf, and Section 981 for Turf Materials. Specifically Specifications Section 981-3.1 describes the Type of Sod Material: "Unless a particular type of sod is called for in the Contract Documents, sod may be either centipede, bahia, or bermuda at the Contractor's option."
