27782: MOT - According to the pedestrian traffic control plan Sessions Road is 3 lanes and the pedestrian traffic is to utilize both paved shoulders outside the active work zone. Sessions is only two lanes (other then at the 407 light) plus the NB shoulder will be removed under clearing and grubbing for the length of the widening (1,080'). Only the SB lane will have a shoulder. The single page MOT plan does not state to alter the striping on sessions road to provide for a NB & SB shoulder during widening. Is the intent for the contractor to provide 24/hr 7 day week flagger coverage at station 10+50 & 21+00 to facilitate pedestrian and bike traffic during the widening construction? Additionally, The MOT plan does not address the double SB lanes at 407 and how this will be configured when WB 407 to NB Sessions movement is severally compromised by the elimination of the radius. Please provide clarifications
