Proposers and other interested parties are informed that the above referenced documents are hereby revised, changed and supplemented as set forth below:

GENERAL

Section 4-4.1 of the Scope (Page 21), fifth paragraph has been deleted and replaced by the following:

The Department is not a "Sunshine 811" member. The Contractor shall determine conflict and mark the horizontal route of the ITS facilities when work to be performed by others is in the vicinity of ITS facilities. The Contractor shall mark the horizontal route of all ITS facilities one (1) time when noticed by the Department at the start of a new Department Construction project. Review plans which may include Permit operations to identify potential conflicts with the ITS infrastructure and provide a recommendation and justification of locate/designate requirements in accordance with the UAM. The Contractor will be responsible for repairs and device Availability and Reliability due to damage to ITS infrastructure regardless of the cause. The Department authorizes the Contractor to pursue recovery against any responsible party for reimbursement of costs incurred in accordance with Section 2.5. When substitutions are proposed for existing systems, they must be equal or surpass the functionality of the existing components. Submit proposed substitutions to the Department for review. The Contractor shall fully accept the risk and responsibility of success or failure for the proposed substitution components, materials, and/or parts. The Department reserves the right to deny the implementation of such components, materials and or parts in the Department's best interest.
