BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS FOR PAVEMENT MARKING REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT

Eligibility qualifications are required to bid on this project for the repair and replacement of pavement marking. A bid not accompanied with documentation of eligibility qualifications as required herein may result in the bid being deemed non-responsive.

In order for a bid to be deemed responsive, the bidder must provide sufficient documentation to satisfy **either** Option 1 (documentation of Experience, Record, and Equipment) **or** Option 2 (documentation of Certificate of Qualification).

Option 1

Documentation demonstrating the bidder's eligibility qualifications:

- A. Experience
- B. Record
- C. Equipment

Option 2

Documentation attesting to the bidder's certificate of qualification status in the work class for Pavement Marking.

Option 1: For eligibility determination based on Option 1, the bidder must provide all details as outlined in sections A., B., and C., of this table.

A. Experience	The bidder must provide evidence of experience in actively performing pavement marking repair or replacement work within the last ten (10) years, for work equivalent to three (3) full years. ➤ List work completed until work experience has a cumulative duration equivalent to three (3) full years, only including work completed within the last ten (10) years. The list of relevant work experience must include the following information: - Contract or project number - Type / description of work - Location work performed (city, state) - Begin and end date of the contract / project - Number of days work performed
B. Record	If relying on experience from contracts with the Florida Department of Transportation in section A., above, for which the bidder was the prime contractor, the performance score received for each of the listed contracts must be a minimum score of eighty (80).
	If relying on experience from contracts not with the Florida Department of Transportation in section A., above, or the bidder was not the prime contractor, the bidder is required to provide a single letter of recommendation from an agency or firm having direct knowledge of the bidder's performance of pavement marking repair or replacement work. The letter of recommendation must include details specific to the agency or firm's direct knowledge of the bidder's performance of pavement marking repair or replacement work.
C. Equipment	The bidder is required to provide a list of equipment owned by the bidder or letters of commitment from equipment rental companies for equipment required to perform the work.

Option 2: For eligibility determination based on Option 2, the bidder must provide a written statement of the bidder's certificate of qualification status.

Certificate of Qualification	Provide a statement attesting that the bidder holds a valid Department of Transportation certificate of qualification in the work class for Pavement Marking.
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
