

Innovative Service Development Grant (ISD) FY2024-25
Questions and Answers

- 1) When is the application package due and do all forms requiring a signature have to be signed upon submission?

Final applications are due no later than April 30, 2024, at 11:59 pm (easter time). Signatures are not required at the time of submission but must be received prior to grant execution, if awarded.

- 2) Can a local municipality with a paratransit service apply for the ISD grant?

The only eligible recipients for this grant are Florida's Community Transportation Coordinators (CTCs). A CTC can partner or contract with a local municipality to propose a project. The CTC would be the grant recipient and be responsible for the project but could contract with the local municipality to complete the project.

- 3) What is the deadline to submit "early" applications for feedback?

Applications submitted by 11:59 pm (eastern time) on March 29, 2024, will be reviewed. Feedback will be provided no later than April 12, 2024.

- 4) Is there a limit to the number of applications a CTC can submit?

There is no limit to the number of applications a CTC can submit. However, a CTC can only be awarded one project per designated service area.
