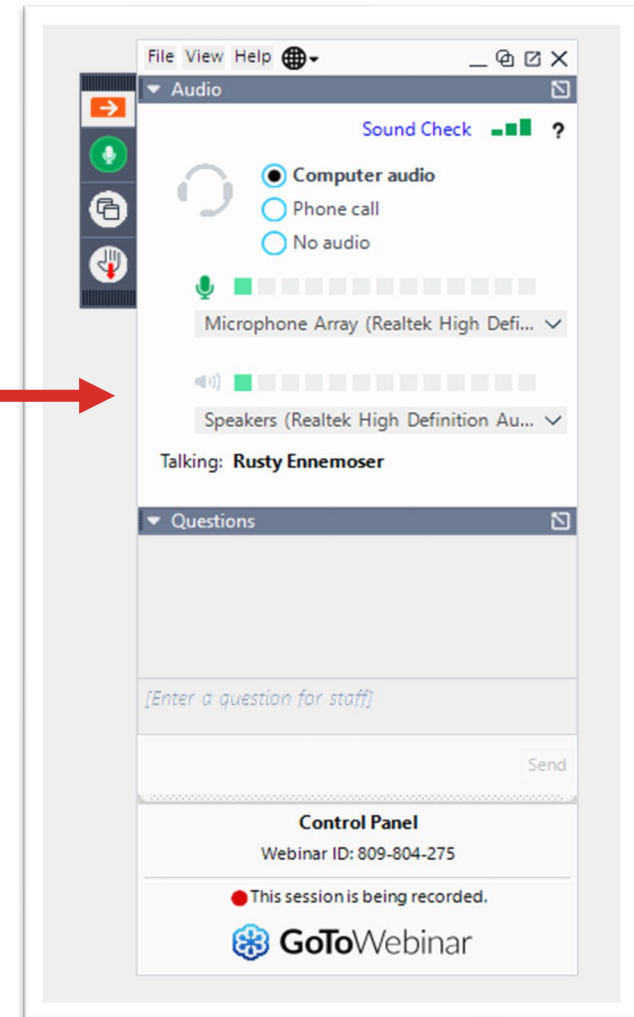

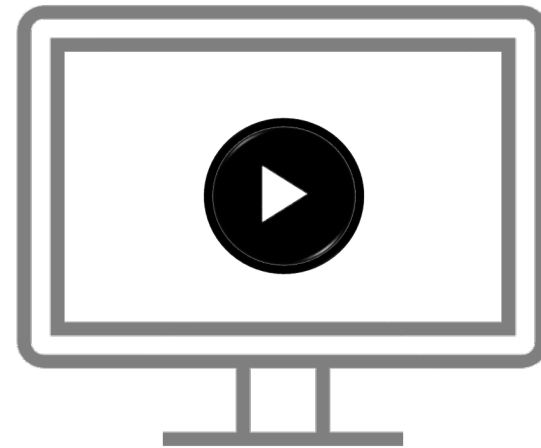

Welcome to the District Three Tentative Work Program

The Five-Year Work Program is our plan for transportation system improvements programmed during the next five years. The Five-Year Work Program includes planning activities, preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition, construction, and public transportation projects within the following 16 counties: Bay, Calhoun, Escambia, Franklin, Gadsden, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, Jefferson, Leon, Liberty, Okaloosa, Santa Rosa, Wakulla, Walton and Washington.

The current **Adopted Five-Year Work Program** covers Fiscal Years 2024 through 2028 (projects programmed July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2028) and was adopted on July 1, 2023. To view and search selections of the adopted with amended and historical versions of the Five-Year Work Program, you may use the [Five-Year Work Program online search tool](#).

The **Tentative Five-Year Work Program** includes projects scheduled for Fiscal Years 2025 through 2029 (projects programmed July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2029). After the public comment period ends, the Tentative Work Program is reviewed by the Florida Legislature and the Governor, which is then adopted by the State Secretary of Transportation on July 1, 2024.

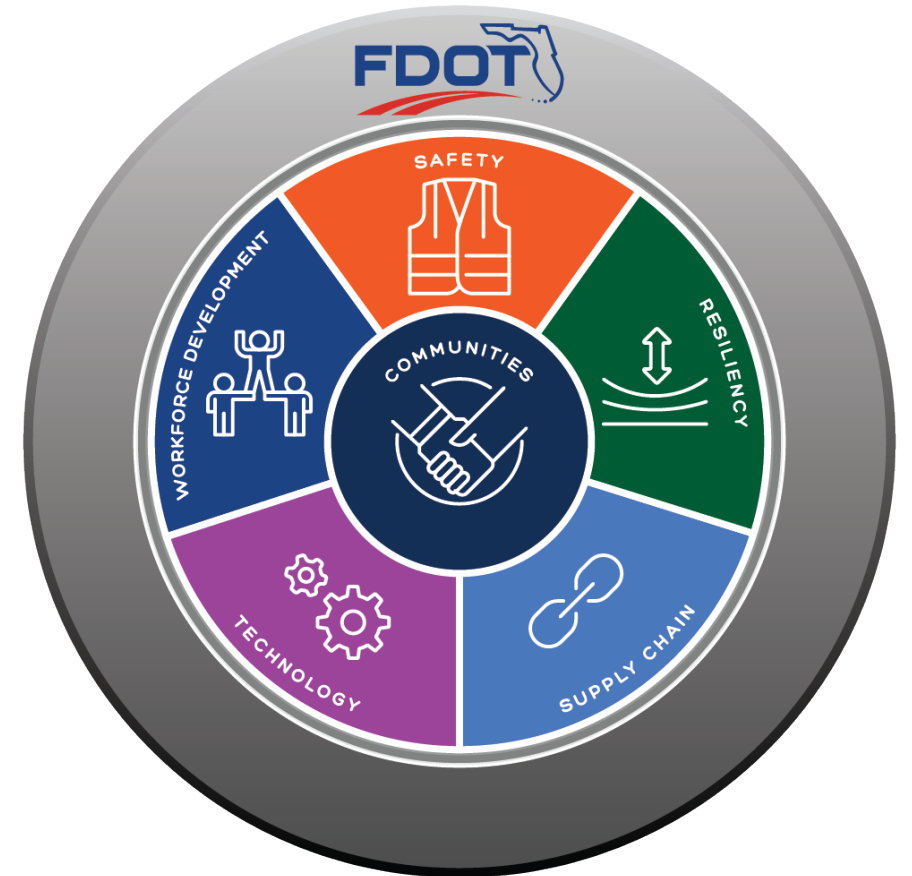

# PUBLIC HEARING General Work Program



- › District Work Program is Stable
- › FDOT maintains construction and right-of-way estimates on an annual basis
- › Continue to see project costs increase with respect to last year
- › The Compass (depicted on right) is used as a guide to develop the Tentative Work Program
- › Goal is to maintain projects that were committed in the common four years related to safety, preservation, and maintenance
- › New phases were generally programmed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> years





# PUBLIC HEARING Work Program Cycle



## **July - September**

- › FDOT prepares District Tentative Work Program in coordination with TPOs, MPOs, and counties
- › Balances District Tentative Work Program to allocations received

## **October**

- › Conduct Public Hearing

## **November**

- › Presentations to Bay County TPO, O-W TPO, FL-AL TPO, and CRTPA



# PUBLIC HEARING Work Program Cycle



## **November - December**

- › FDOT Central Office works with the District to create the Statewide preliminary Tentative Work Program and submits to the Governor, Legislature, Florida Transportation Commission (FTC), and the Department of Economic Opportunity

## **January**

- › FTC holds a statewide public hearing on the preliminary Tentative Work Program

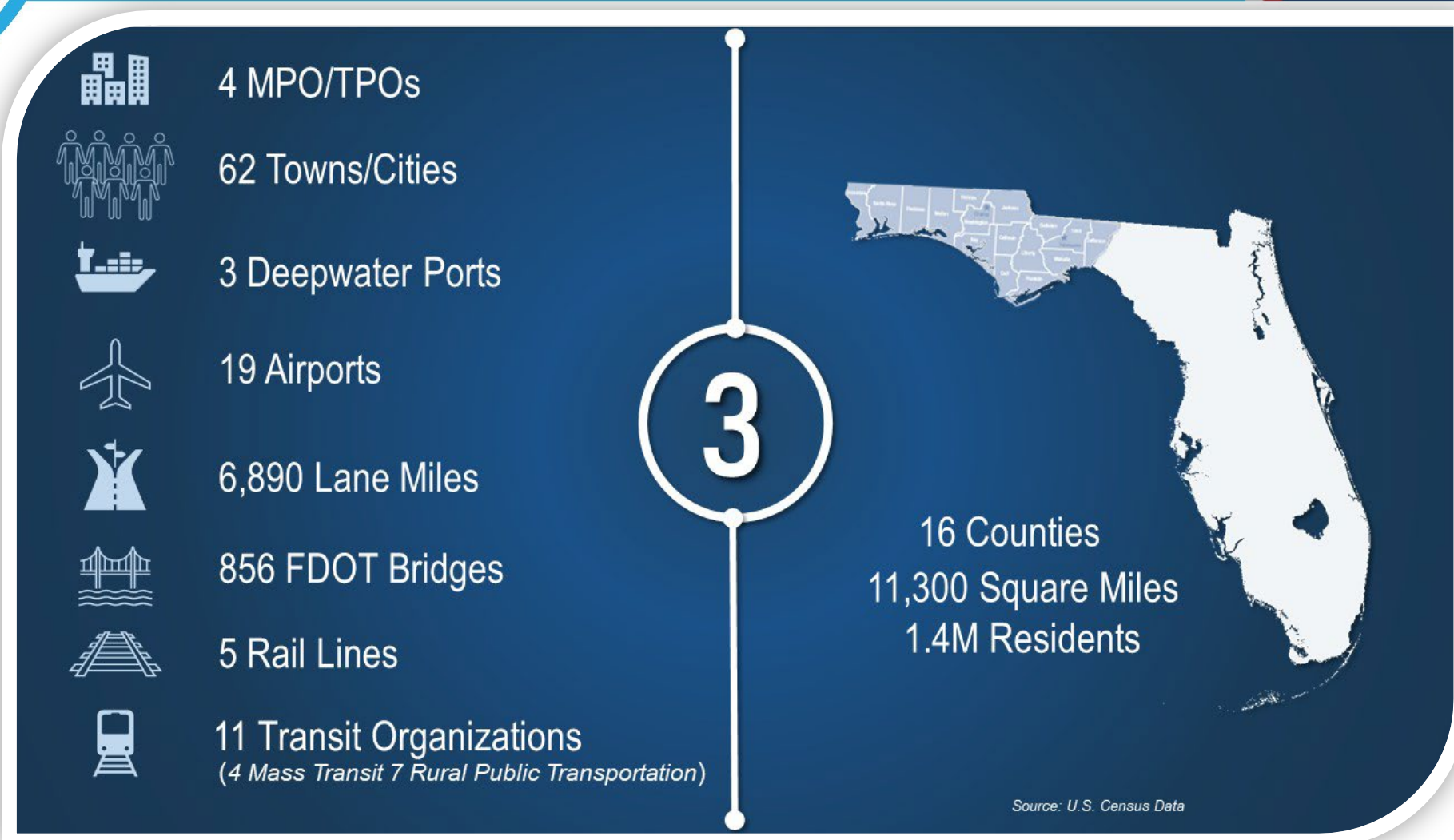
## **July 1<sup>st</sup>**

- › After the budget is approved by the State Legislature and Governor, the Tentative Five-Year Work Program is signed by the FDOT Secretary and becomes the Adopted Five-Year Work Program on July 1st



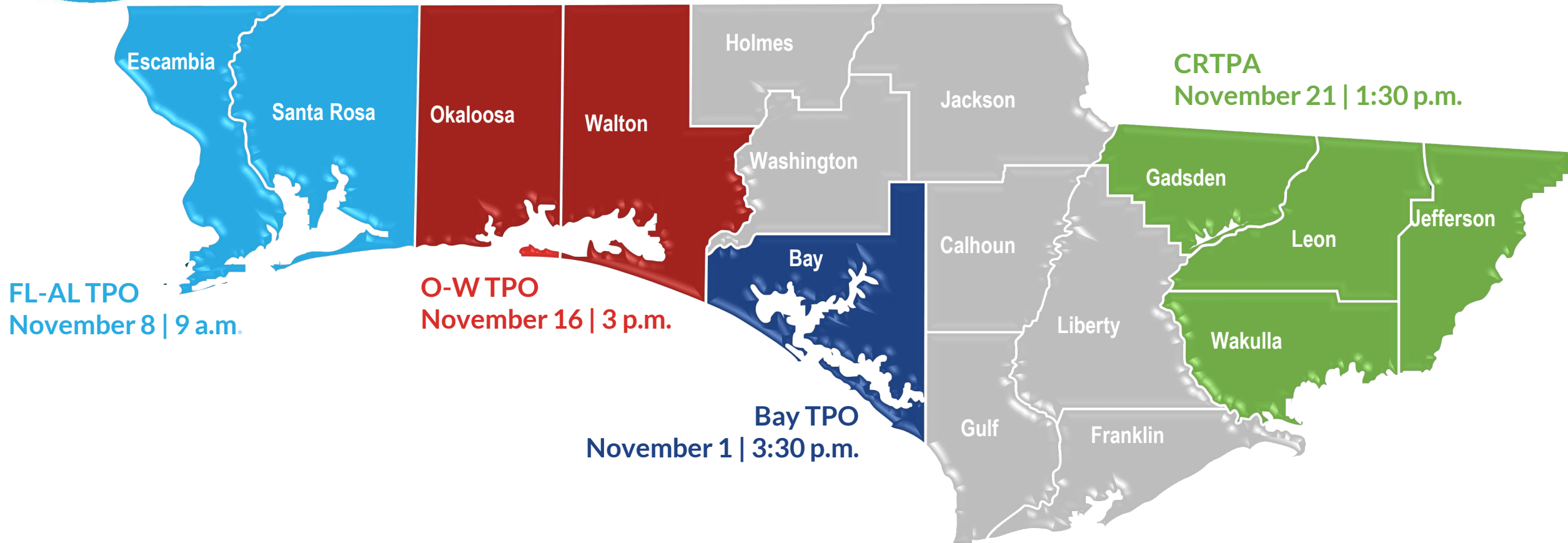
