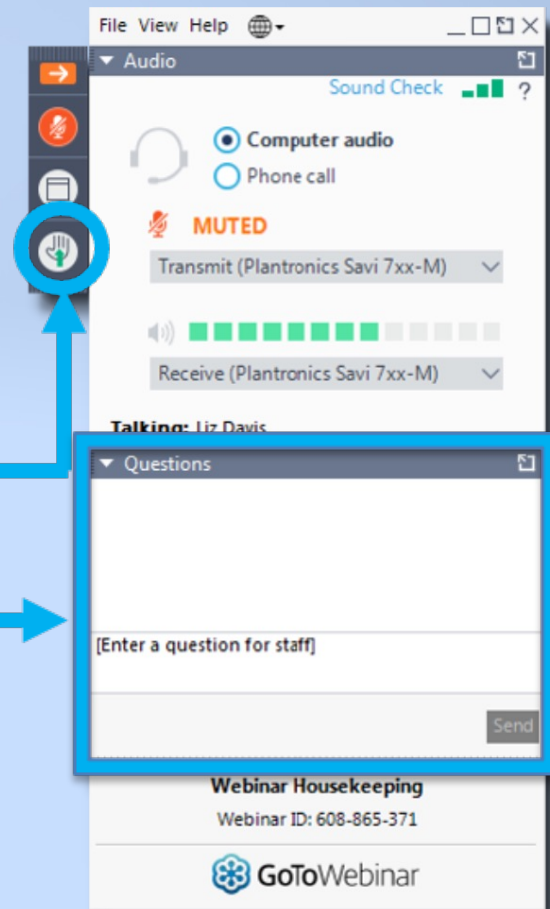

TENTATIVE WORK PROGRAM CYCLE

1

July – October:

- Interacts with elected officials
- Balances TWP to allocations received

2

November:

- Conduct public hearing
- Present to sub-committees

3

December:

- Present to Monroe County Board of County Commissioners
- Present to Miami-Dade County Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) Governing Board

4

January:

- Compiles District plans to create the Statewide Tentative Work Program
- Submits Statewide preliminary Draft Tentative Work Program to Governor's Office, Legislature, Florida Transportation Commission & Department of Economic Opportunity

5

March:

- Florida Transportation Commission conducts a statewide public hearing to receive public input for the Tentative Work Program

6

July:

- After the appropriations are approved by the Legislature, the Work Program is adopted by the FDOT State Secretary

- Construction in 2027
- CST Cost - \$208 million

OVERSEAS HIGHWAY (MM 108.4 TO 112.8)

RESURFACING

Status:

- Design is underway
- Construction in 2024
- CST Cost - \$16.4 million

REHABILITATION AND REPLACEMENT

Rehabilitation Project Status:

- Design in 2023
- Construction in 2026
- CST Cost - \$16.7 million

Replacement Project Status:

- PD&E in 2024
- Design/RFP in 2026
- Construction in 2030
- CST Cost - \$677 million

- CST Cost - \$10 million

RECONSTRUCTION

Status:

- Design for all segment is underway

Status: Michigan Ave to 43 St

- Construction in 2025
- CST Cost - \$40 million

Status: Northern Segments

- CST - Unfunded





FLAGLER STREET DEMONSTRATION PROJECT

Status:

- Design in 2023
- Construction in 2024
- CST Cost - \$4.9 million



GOLDEN GLADES

INTERCHANGE RECONSTRUCTION

Status for all 8 projects:

- Design is underway
- Construction in 2024
- CST Cost - \$578 million



SR 9A/I-95

CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS

Status: US 1 to 62 St

- PD&E in 2025
 - Cost - \$6.5 million
- Design in 2028
 - Cost - \$9.4 million

Status: 62 Street to 143 St

- PD&E in 2024
 - Cost - \$3.5 million
- Design in 2027
 - Cost - \$5.2 million

Status: Miami Gardens Dr to Broward Line

- PD&E is underway
- Design in 2023
- Cost - \$18.3 million





LUDLAM TRAIL

NEW BRIDGES OVER BIRD RD, 8 ST & FLAGLER ST

Status:

- Design in 2024
- Construction in 2026
- CST Cost - \$35 million



MIAMI GARDENS DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION

Status: I-75 to 79 Place

- Design is underway
- Construction in 2025
- CST Cost - \$14 million

Status: Eastern Segments

- Unfunded



OKEECHOBEE ROAD

RECONSTRUCTION

Design for all segments: Underway

Status: 87 Ave to 79 Ave

- Construction in 2025
- CST Cost - \$41 million

Status: Okeechobee & Palmetto Interchange

- Construction in 2025
- CST Cost - \$130 million

Status: 116 Way to 87 Ave

- Construction in 2026
- CST Cost - \$270 million



PALMETTO SOUTH **IMPROVEMENTS**

Status:

- PD&E is underway
- Design in 2025
 - Cost - \$30 million
- Right-of-Way
 - Partially funded
 - Beginning 2026



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NE 79 STREET

BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

Status:

- PD&E is underway
- Design in 2025
 - Cost - \$3.2 million
- Construction in 2028
 - CST Cost - \$37 million



NORTHEAST CORRIDOR

SMART PROGRAM COMMUTER RAIL

Status:

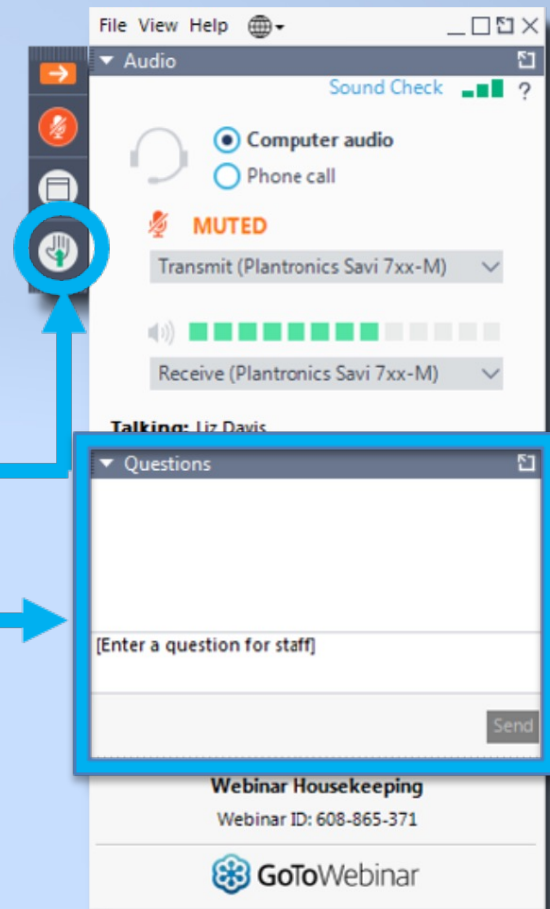
- Department contribution
 - \$34.5 million 2025, 2026 & 2027
- Total contribution - \$103.5 million
