



ABBREVIATED CYCLE

JULY - SEPTEMBER:

Interact with elected officials. Balances
TWP to allocations received.

OCTOBER:

Conduct Public Hearing and present to sub-committees.

OCTOBER/NOVEMBER:

Present to Monroe County Board of County Commissioners and Miami-Dade County Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) Governing Board.

DECEMBER:

Compile District plans to create the Statewide Tentative Work Program. Submit Statewide preliminary Draft Tentative Work Program to Governor's Office, Legislature, Florida Transportation Commission and Department of Economic Opportunity.

JANUARY:

Florida Transportation Commission (FTC) conducts a statewide public hearing to receive public input for the Tentative Work Program. The Legislature also convenes in January.

JULY:

After the appropriations are approved by the Legislature, the Work Program is adopted by the FDOT State Secretary.




