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SUBJECT: Standard Plans Interim Revision (IR700-010-1), Single Column Ground Signs

This bulletin announces the release of *Standard Plans, Interim Revision IR700-010-1* which updates the details for flip signs in the FY 2022-23 Standard Plans, Index 700-010 (Single Column Ground Signs).

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

Standard Plans, Index 700-010 has been updated and is released as a Standard Plans Interim Revision (IR 700-010-1) to the FY 2022-23 Standard Plans.

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The Interim Revision will replace the original version of the Index published on October 27, 2021; therefore, a reference to the Interim Revision is not required on the Key Sheet under the Governing Standard Plans.

## **COMMENTARY**

This *Standard Plans Interim Revision* replaces the "Wind Beam Connection for Flip Up Sign" details (Sheet 7) with a new flip down sign design and new latch details on Sheet 8. All remaining sheets of *Standard Plans, Index 700-010* are renumbered to coincide with the addition of the new Sheet 8.

The hinged flip signs are primarily used for emergency management (evacuation/shelter routes and emergency shoulder use).

### **IMPLEMENTATION**

This change is effective on projects with a letting on or after July 1, 2022. These requirements may be implemented immediately at the discretion of the Districts.
