WRONG-WAY and DO NOT ENTER signs are to be oriented in a direction that is visible to drivers opposing the correct direction of travel or entering the roadway from the opposing side. Use engineering judgment to determine if a sign should or should not be oriented in a direction to enhance safety or visibility (i.e., WRONG-WAY signs should not be perpendicular to, or rotated towards, drivers traveling in the correct direction of travel). On exit ramps, verify if a 45-degree orientation is appropriate for the ramp geometry.

Specify in Plans, sign orientations that need to differ from the Standard Plans.
