

- 2. L = Taper LengthX = Work Zone Sign Spacing B = Buffer LengthSee Index 102-600 for "L", "X", "B", and channelizing device spacing values.
- 3. For incidental work (e.g. mowing or litter removal), only the Road Work Ahead sign
- 4. When four or more work vehicles enter the through traffic lanes in a one hour period (excluding establishing and terminating the work area), use a flagger or lane closure to accommodate work vehicle ingress and
- 5. For work less than two feet from the traveled way and work zone speed is greater than 45 MPH, use a lane closure.
- 6. The "Speeding Fines Doubled When Workers Present"signs (MOT-13-06) and "End Road Work" Signs (G20-2) along with the associated work zone sign spacing distances may be omitted when the temporary condition is in place for 24 hours or less.
- 7. Temporary pavement markings may be omitted when the work zone is in place for 3 days or less.
- 8. If the work encroaches on a marked bicycle lane or ridable shoulder, close the lane or shoulder in accordance with the Plans.
- 9. Omit "Shoulder Closed" signs (W21-5a) along with associated work zone sign spacing distances for work on the median



SHOULDER WORK LESS THAN 2' FROM THE TRAVELED WAY WITH WORK ZONE SPEED OF 45 MPH OR LESS




