## **COMMENT:**

1. This item is titled Haul Road Crossing, but it could apply to any activity during construction that requires use of temporary traffic signal including others in Revised 102-606. Consider putting this back in 102-606 and Sheet 2 of 2, with title "Intersection Controlled by Temporary Traffic Signal". Could create a special list "Notes for Haul Road" and include notes 4 and 7 in that. In Note 1, delete the word "haul" for more generic use.

**RESPONSE:** Comment acknowledged; however, the details are based on MUTCD application for Haul Roads. If a temporary intersection is needed on a project there would have to be project specific TTC Plans.
