COMMENT: Minor issue with 711-001: On sheet 11 of 13 (proposed new sheet number), with the notes for the accessible markings, Note 4 calls for tinting the blue pavement markings to match color 15180 of Fed Std 595a. This is in conflict with the spec language below.

971-1. 6 Color: Materials other than white and yellow shall meet the color requirements as identified in 23 CFR 665 Table 5 Appendix to Part 655, Subpart F.

Since the specification is the best location to address material requirements, please remove note 4.

NOTE: We currently do not have any blue materials listed on the APL. Per 971, this is a requirement. This issue also needs to be resolved.

RESPONSE: Based on this request and confirmation from SMO Note 4 referencing Federal

Standard 15180 on Sheet 11 will be deleted.


REVERSE-IN PARKING
