COMMENT: Would it be prudent to be consistent with the revisions to Index 715-001 luminaire tilt detail, by swapping out the graphical representations of the cobrahead fixtures with LED fixtures in all the details in Index 715-002?

RESPONSE: The light pole in Index 715-001 is now referenced to 715-002, so it won't be misinterpreted for something different. Currently, the basic luminaire visual in 715-002 allows for better visibility of the pole dimensions. Adding the more detailed luminaire graphic in 715-002 is not necessary, but it is logged for consideration in next year's publication.
