COMMENT: I would consider adding a time constraint to when this Option II would be applicable. If long-term, then I think the barrier wall option would need to be utilized. I would recommend the 2' min dimension to be modified to be 2' clear to avoid LCD's and Ped LCDs being intertwined. I would not want the Ped LCDs to be close enough to be touched by vehicular traffic in constrained conditions such as 10' lanes.

RESPONSE: Option 2 is only applicable when the minimal length of need required for low profile barriers cannot be met. This can be found in the SPI for 102-660.
