This letter constitutes the official “Notice to Proceed” for the Savannah Road Resurfacing & Bike Lanes project for all work associated in the Contract including but not limited to *milling, resurfacing, and roadway widening to add bike lanes along NE Savannah Road. The scope of work also includes the installation of drainage piping and exfiltration piping/trench, erosion control, clearing and grubbing, excavation, fill and embankment, drainage structures and piping, bahia sod, and other incidental work as shown and specified in the Contract Documents.* The lump sum fee for this contract is **\$1,046,885.65**.

EXHIBIT A TO NOTICE TO PROCEED

MARTIN COUNTY'S NOTICE AND CONTRACTOR'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF CONTRACTUAL LIQUIDATED DAMAGES PROVISIONS

Community Asphalt, Corp. (the "Contractor") is hereby notified by Martin County (the "County") and acknowledges the following:

1. Article 7 of the contract between Martin County and Contractor dated March 24, 2020, (the "Contract") for the construction of **Savannah Road Resurfacing & Bike Lanes project** specifically provides the following:

7.1 Upon failure of the CONTRACTOR to Substantially Complete the Agreement within the specified period of time, plus approved time extensions, the CONTRACTOR shall pay to the COUNTY daily liquidated damages in the amount shown on Page 1 of this Agreement to reflect the COUNTY's estimated damages resulting from the delay to Substantial Completion.

7.2 Upon failure of the CONTRACTOR to Finally Complete the Agreement within the specified period of time, plus approved time extensions, the CONTRACTOR shall pay to the COUNTY daily liquidated damages in the amount shown on Page 1 of this Agreement to reflect the COUNTY's estimated damages resulting from the delay to Final Completion.

7.3 Milestones, milestone completion dates, and applicable Liquidated Damages shall be in accordance with the Contract Documents.

7.4 If the milestones are not strictly complied with, then Liquidated Damages will be assessed against the CONTRACTOR, which are agreed upon, and it is further agreed that such Liquidated Damages bear a reasonable relationship to damages to be incurred by the COUNTY, and are not a penalty.

2. The Contract further provides on page 1 that daily liquidated damages for delays in substantial completion is the amount of \$1,665.00, and the daily liquidated damages for final completion is the amount of \$1,665.00.

3. The Contractor acknowledges the Contractor and the County stipulated in advance the amount to be paid as liquidated damages in the event of a breach as provided in the Contract, and further, the Contractor and the County so stipulated because the damages from a breach were not readily ascertainable at the time of the drawing of the Contact.

4. The Contractor further acknowledges the liquidated damages provisions of the Contract are not a penalty.

5. Nothing in this Notice and Acknowledgment shall constitute a waiver of any affirmative defense the Contractor may have to any claim of liquidated damages other than the amount of the liquidated damages as provided in the Contract.

6. The Contractor signs this Notice and Acknowledgement through its duly authorized representative and does so voluntarily and without duress after reading the foregoing in its entirety.

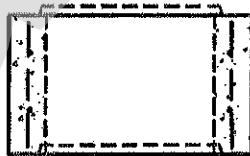

Please find the Change Order # 2 (Overrun/Underrun) request for 438342-1 Savannah Rd Resurfacing for FDOT concurrence.

Justification/Clarification:

1. The Sod tickets and quantity calculations have been verified by field inspection. The Contractor charged us less than bid price for the overage due to their miscalculations and that of the plans.
2. We have included the invoice for installation of the traffic window that was verified by Martin County to be a fair price.
3. We have attached the invoice and back up for charge-backs from geotesting delays and failed tests per Community's contract with Martin County in section 1010 of the Technical Specifications: 2.2 Coordination #C.

The CONTRACTOR shall coordinate with the COUNTY'S soils and material testing consultants. The CONTRACTOR is responsible for scheduling and coordinating all soil and material testing required in the performance the Work. Unless otherwise specified in the Contract Documents, the number and frequency of soils and material testing shall be in accordance with the FDOT Guidelines for Sampling and Testing. The COUNTY will pay for costs associated with the initial soils and material testing and the CONTRACTOR will be liable for costs associated with re-testing as a result of initial test failure due to deficiencies in the CONTRACTOR'S work efforts.

The work is a change to the current contract. Martin County is not asking the District for any additional funding.

When so executed, such instruments shall be as binding as if signed by the President and attested to by the Secretary. Any power or authority granted to any representative or attorney-in-fact under the provisions of this article may be revoked at any time by the Board, the Chairman, the President or by the officer or officers granting such power or authority.

ARTICLE XIII – Execution of Contracts: Section 5. Surety Bonds and Undertakings.

Any officer of the Company authorized for that purpose in writing by the chairman or the president, and subject to such limitations as the chairman or the president may prescribe, shall appoint such attorneys-in-fact, as may be necessary to act in behalf of the Company to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations. Such attorneys-in-fact subject to the limitations set forth in their respective powers of attorney, shall have full power to bind the Company by their signature and execution of any such instruments and to attach thereto the seal of the Company. When so executed such instruments shall be as binding as if signed by the president and attested by the secretary.

Certificate of Designation – The President of the Company, acting pursuant to the Bylaws of the Company, authorizes David M. Carey, Assistant Secretary to appoint such attorneys-in-fact as may be necessary to act on behalf of the Company to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations.

Authorization – By unanimous consent of the Company's Board of Directors, the Company consents that facsimile or mechanically reproduced signature of any assistant secretary of the Company, wherever appearing upon a certified copy of any power of attorney issued by the Company in connection with surety bonds, shall be valid and binding upon the Company with the same force and effect as though manually affixed.
